



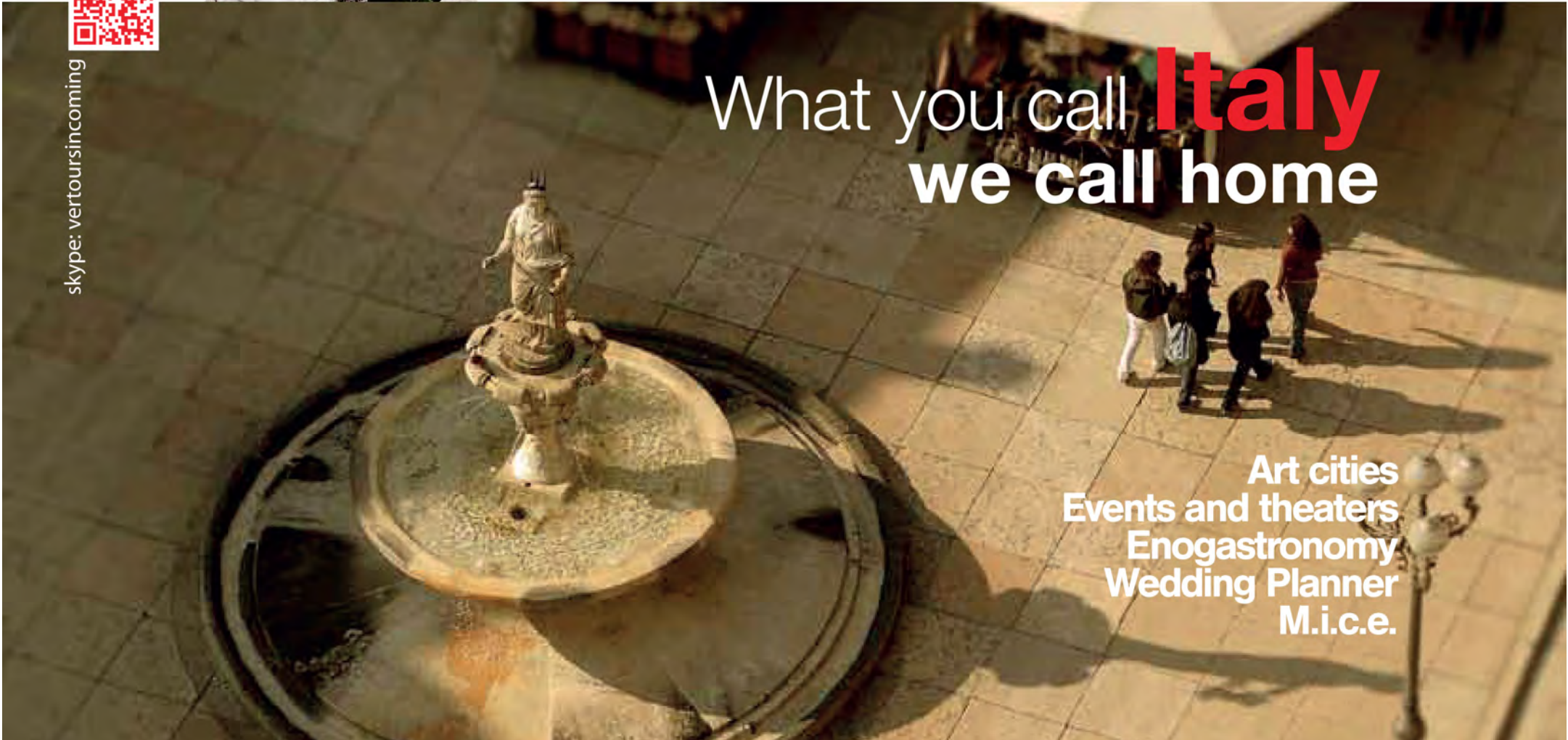

# ➤ TOUR: VENETO AND THE DOLOMITES



## **Day 1 DEPARTURE FROM YOUR CITY**

Check in at the airport three hours earlier, boarding to Venice. Overnight flight.

## **Day 2 VENICE HALF DAY WITH LUNCH**

Arrival in Venice, airport pick up and transfer to the hotel. The rest of the morning is free for personal activities. In the afternoon, city tour in Venice (4-hour long), beginning with Piazza San Marco and then sightseeing tour of the Floating City. Enjoy the view of Saint Mark's Basilica, the Watch Tower and the Doge's Palace, symbol of Venetian power, from there the story of the Bridge of Sighs will be told. The tour finishes with a watertaxi ride to Murano to visit a glass factory. Lunch included. Free time for shopping. Dinner and overnight in Venice.

## **Day 3 VENICE CORTINA D'AMPEZZO**

After breakfast, we proceed to Cortina d'Ampezzo, "The Pearl of the Dolomites". The Venetian mountains offer a fairytale view. Specifically, the Dolomites are an artwork of perfection, which the whole world admires. Arrival and check in at the hotel. Free time. Enjoy a nice walk while experiencing the soft breeze and the magnificent Alpine landscape. There are also exclusive shops. Dinner at the hotel and overnight.

## **Day 4 CORTINA D'AMPEZZO PADUA**

After breakfast, we proceed to visit Cortina and then we head to Cime di Lavaredo. There, we will have free time for a walk and lunch (included). Right after lunch, we carry on to Padua. Upon arrival, check in at the hotel, dinner and overnight.

## **Day 5 PADUA BURCHIELLO TOUR UP TO ORIAGO**

After breakfast, we proceed to Padua river harbor. By 8 a.m., we go aboard this 16th century landing platform, an old river navigation port. We embark on a quick cruise through Brenta river, passing by the wonderful villas, such as Giovanelli's in Noventa Padovana. By 9:20 a.m., we arrive in Stra. There, we will visit Villa Pisani, and then the cruise proceeds, passing by many Villas, little villages until the arrival at Oriago, where the lunch is included. After lunchtime, private coach transfer back to Padua. Dinner at the hotel and overnight.

## **Day 6 PADUA VERONA**

After breakfast, we leave Padua and head to Verona. In Padua, city tour including the iconic St. Anthony's basilica. Among other things, Padua is worldly famous as the place where Saint Anthony, famous Portuguese Franciscan (also known as Saint Anthony of Lisbon, where he was born in 1195), lived for many years and died in 1231. The local people celebrate the anniversary of his death on June 13. After lunch, we will proceed to Verona, where the Adige River crosses the city. The hills around Verona set the harmony and beauty of Romeo and Juliet's city. Check in at the hotel, dinner and overnight in Verona.

## **Day 7 VERONA CITY TOUR AND WINE TASTING IN SOAVE**

Breakfast at the hotel. Panoramic view of the city from the top of the surrounding hills. We will take a walk through the historical center passing by the main city squares and monuments: Piazza Bra, Arena, Juliet's House, Piazza delle Erbe, Torre dei Lamberti, Piazza dei Signori, Della Scala graves, Sant'Anastasia Church, Porta Borsari and Castelvecchio. The tour lasts 4 hours. Lunch at a typical Veronese inn. Return to the hotel for relax time. Around 4 p.m., we proceed to Soave, a small medieval village.

We will take a little walk through the historical center, discovering Soave Castle and its walls. The tour continues with a visit to a wine cellar where we will have a small tasting of the famous Soave Classico and Veronese Mount seasoned cheese. Time for dinner in a typical restaurant. Return to the hotel and overnight.

## **Day 8 VERONA SIRMIONE VERONA**

Breakfast. In the morning, we will visit the charming village of Sirmione and the fantastic panoramic view of Lake Garda. We will stop for a boat ride (if the weather permits), when we may see Maria Callas' house and Catullus Grottoes. Lunch included. After lunch, we go back to Verona. Free time for a walk in the city. Dinner and overnight.

## **Day 9 VERONA MANTUA FLORENCE**

Breakfast. Departure to Florence, stopping for lunch at the medieval city of Mantua. Mantua has an unpaired architecture, with houses, churches, museums and , palace still carefully preserved, that belonged to the lords that ruled the city political destiny. After eating a typical meal, we will proceed to the capital of Tuscany, which flourished during the Renaissance and today is known as "the oldest modern city in the world". Arrival and check in. Free time, dinner and overnight.

## Day 10 FLORENCE CITY TOUR

After breakfast, 4-hour city tour in Florence, sightseeing in the historical center, starting from the Cathedral, Giotto's Bell Tower, the Baptistery and its famous Gate of Heaven and Brunelleschi's spectacular dome. We will head to Piazza della Signoria (an authentic outdoor museum of Renaissance sculptures), which was the heart of Florence and Medici family. We will walk through the beautiful streets and squares, like Piazza della Repubblica and Ponte Vecchio. Lunchtime and free time for shopping. Dinner at a typical restaurant in the city center. Return to the hotel and overnight.

## Day 11 FLORENCE ASSISI ROME

Breakfast. Early in the morning, we leave to Assisi, where we are going to visit Saint Francis' Basilica and the city center. Then, we proceed to Rome. Free afternoon. Dinner at the hotel. Overnight.

## Day 12 ROME CITY TOUR

Breakfast. Sightseeing tour of Rome by coach, passing by the classic Roman monuments, as Piazza della Repubblica, Rome Cathedrals, the Archeological Rome, the Baths of Caracalla, Circus Maximus, the Coliseum and the Forum. We will head through Piazza Venezia, Saint Angelo's Castle, the exterior of Saint Peter's Basilica and Square (according to religious ceremonies). Lunch. Free afternoon. Dinner at the hotel. Overnight.

## Day 1 DEPARTURE FROM YOUR CITY

Check in at the airport three hours earlier for the boarding to Milan. Overnight flight.

## Day 2 MILAN

Arrival in Milan, airport pick up and check in at the hotel. Afterwards a 4-hour city tour walking through the main touristic attractions, such as Piazza del Duomo, Gothic Cathedral, Vittorio Emmanuelle II Galleria and Alla Scala Theater. Lunch (included). Free time for personal shopping. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

## Day 3 MILAN SIRMIONE VERONA

Breakfast. Departure to Verona, stopping at the charming village of Sirmione and the fantastic panoramic view of Lake Garda. We will enjoy a boat ride (if the weather permits), then we may see Maria Callas' house and Catullus Grottoes. Lunch included.

Prosecution to Verona, where Adige River crosses the city. The hills surrounding Verona set the harmony and beauty of Romeo and Juliet's city. Upon arrival in Verona, check in at the hotel, dinner and overnight.

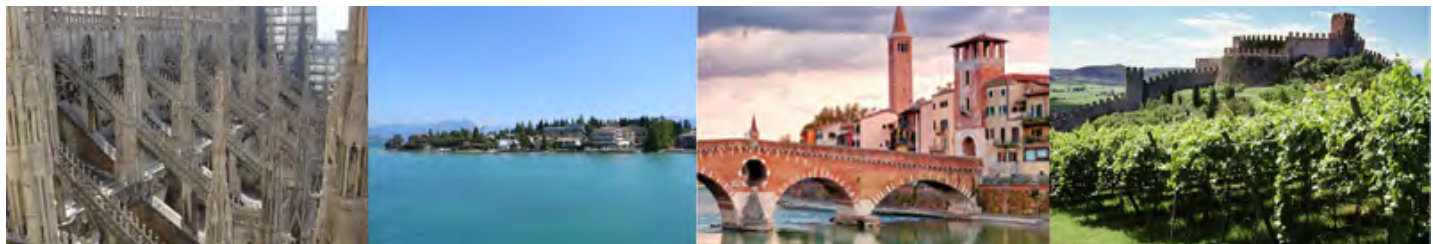

## Day 8 FLORENCE ASSISI ROME

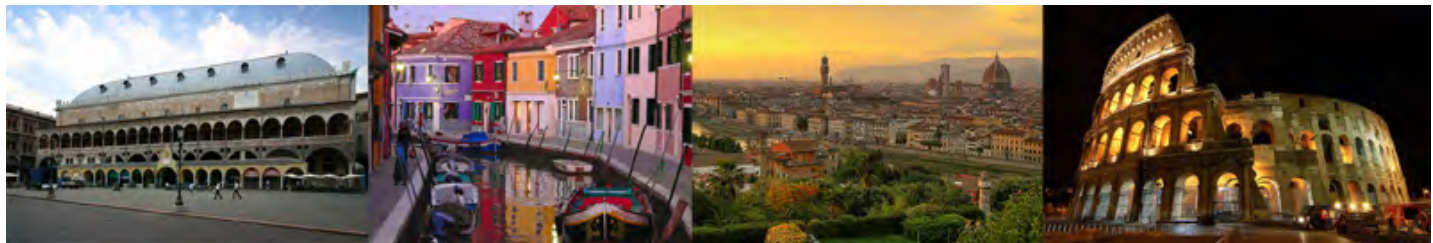

Arrival in Sorrento and free time to visit the historical center of the village and its gorgeous cathedral. We suggest a walk through Corso Italia, a street that attracts many tourists and local inhabitants, enjoying the cafes and restaurants, especially the ones located in Piazza Tasso. Return to Naples. Dinner and overnight.

## DAY 13 NAPLES - ROME BOARDING TO NEXT DESTINATION

Breakfast. Departure from the hotel to Rome airport 3h30 minutes before scheduled flight time. Travel overnight. **Our services finish here.**

## Day 1 DEPARTURE FROM YOUR CITY

Check in at the airport three hours earlier to boarding to Rome. Overnight flight.

## Day 2 ROME CITY TOUR

Arrival in Rome, airport pick up and transfer to the hotel. The rest of the morning is free for personal activities. Lunch at the hotel. In the afternoon, a 4-hour city tour in Rome. The capital of Italy, Rome was, for centuries, the political and religious center of western civilization, capital of Roman Empire and place of the Holy See. After the decline of the Roman Empire, Italy was conquered by many people. Centuries later, Italy became the cradle of the Renaissance, intellectual movement that formed the European mindset. Modern Italy is a democratic republic, having one of the top ten best quality life ratings in the world. Sightseeing tour of Rome by coach, passing by the classic Roman monuments, as Piazza della Repubblica, the Cathedral of Rome, the Archeological Rome, the Baths of Caracalla, Circus Maximus, the Coliseum and the Forum. We will head through Piazza Venezia, Saint Angelo's Castle, the exterior of Saint Peter's Basilica and Square (depending on the religious ceremonies). Return to the hotel and walk to Trastevere district, famous for its colorful restaurants. Dinner in a typical inn. The participants must return to the hotel on their own. Overnight.

## Day 3 ROME ASSISI

Breakfast. (The schedule will be confirmed the night before.) Departure to Assisi. Arrival and free time to visit the small town, surrounded by walls in different medieval style. We recommend visiting the famous Saint Francis' basilica hosting some Giotto's masterpieces. Free time for lunch (not included). Free afternoon. Dinner in the hotel and overnight.

## Day 4 ASSISI SIENA FLORENCE

Breakfast in the hotel and departure to Florence. The trip goes on along the road that crosses the Italian Peninsula from north to south. Then we will arrive in Siena. Lunch stop (one hour). Monumental and medieval, surrounded by great walls, Siena is famous for having one of the most beautiful squares in the world: Piazza del Campo, where people celebrate the "Palio delle Contrade" in summer, twice a year. Our trip continues to Florence. Arrival and check in at the hotel. Free time in the afternoon. Dinner at the hotel and overnight.

## Day 5 FLORENCE CITY TOUR

Breakfast. In the morning, we are visiting the fabulous city where the Italian cleverness showed up in all its splendour and purity. The city center, as well the Bell Tower, the Baptistery and the Cathedral, constitute an extraordinary set of white, green and pink marbles, and through them we may appreciate the transition of Florentine art from Middle Age to Renaissance. Visit at the cathedral Santa María del Fiore, symbol of Florence richness and power. Brunelleschi's Dome, in contrast to the silhouette of the Bell Tower by Giotto, the Baptistery and the famous Gates of Brass (including the Gates of Heaven, named by Michelangelo). Walk through Piazza della Signoria and see Palazzo Vecchio, an austere-looking gothic building. Finally, visit Santa Croce's basilica, which opens to one of the most ancient squares of the city. Free afternoon for personal activities. Dinner in a typical restaurant. Overnight.

## Day 6 FLORENCE FERRARA VENICE

Breakfast. Transfer in the morning to Venice with a stop in Ferrara, a medieval town that flourished during the Renaissance and today is known as "the oldest city in the world". Time for lunch (included). Arrival in Venice and transfer to the hotel with watertaxi.

## Day 7 VENICE CITY TOUR

Breakfast. Starting from Piazza San Marco, we begin our sightseeing tour of the so called "Floating City". Enjoy the view of Saint Mark's Basilica, the Bell Tower and the Doge's Palace, symbol of Venetian power, from where the story of the Bridge of Sighs will be told. The tour continues with a motorboat cruise to Murano to pay a visit to a glass workshop. Free time for lunch. Return to the hotel and typical dinner in a Venetian restaurant. Overnight.

Check in at the hotel, dinner and overnight in Verona.

The local people celebrate the anniversary of his death on June 13. Proceeding to Bevilacqua, we will have lunch there. Afterwards, we will head to Este. The tourists will have time to visit this Medieval village and its main attraction, Carrarese Castle, built in 1339. Today, the castle has a very suggestive indoor garden. After the tour, we will carry on to Verona, where Adige River crosses the city. The hills around Verona set the harmony and beauty of Romeo and Juliet's city. Check in at the hotel, dinner and overnight in Verona.



## **Day 4 VERONA CITY TOUR**

After breakfast, a panoramic view of the city from the top of the surrounding hills. We will take a walk through the historical center passing by the main city squares and monuments: Piazza Bra, Arena, Juliet's House, Piazza delle Erbe, Torre dei Lamberti, Piazza dei Signori, Della Scala graves, St. Anastasia Church, Porta Borsari and Castelveccchio. The tour lasts 4 hours. Lunch at a typical Veronese restaurant. Return to the hotel for relax, free time, dinner and overnight.

## Day 7 ALBA - BAROLO - MARCHESI DI BAROLO - TURIN

Breakfast and departure to Turin. We will enjoy a tour in the south of Piedmont, a predominantly agricultural region where some of the best Italian wines are produced. We will discover a picturesque town called Barolo. Then we will visit Cantine dei Marchesi di Barolo, close to Castello Falletto di Barolo, built in 10th century as a ramparts against invasions. Later it became residence of French marquise Juliette Colbert, who created Barolo wine. Visit to the wine cellar inside the castle, which presents a great selection of the best wines produced in the region. Lunch (included) at the restaurant, heading to Turin. At the hotel, free time, dinner and overnight.

## Day 8 TURIN CITY TOUR

After breakfast, city tour in Turin, including a visit to Duomo and its Renaissance style, built in honor to Saint John the Baptist. This place holds the famous and controversial Saint Shroud (not exposed), as well Palazzo Carignano and its splendid Baroque façade. By the end of the visit, chocolate tasting at Guido Gobino's café. Lunch included. In the afternoon, we will visit the famous Venaria Reale. Be allured by the beauty of the Royal Palace, Savoia's royal residence, located outside Turin, and acknowledged as World Heritage Site in 1997. Carlo Emanuele II called it "Palace of Pleasure", because he believed that there he could hunt like the kings did. The palace hosts royal wonders: from Diana's living room, designed by Amedeo di Castellamonte, to the solemnity of Saint Hubert's Gallery and Chapel. Return to Turin, dinner at a typical Piedmontese restaurant. Overnight.





# TOUR: WONDERFUL ITALY

## Day 9 TURIN - CINQUE TERRE (PORTOFINO) - CAMOGLI

After breakfast, we proceed to Liguria to visit Portofino, one of the many wonders located on the Italian Riviera. Many people consider it as the eighth wonder of the world. The small village has no more than 500 inhabitants, as well as an unparalleled bay kind of a natural amphitheater. Portofino became famous in the 1960s, as a favorite destination for Dolce Vita's rich and famous characters: actors, actresses, pop stars and royalties. ## 1 DAY | VERONA

Visit of Verona by private coach and guide: Verona historical centre, St. Anastasia, the Scaligeri Monuments, Piazza Erbe, Juliet's House, Arena. Overnight in hotel.

## 2 DAY | VERONA | VALPOLICELLA | VERONA | BORGHETTO

Pick up in hotel with guide and transfer to San Floriano and San Giorgio Ingannapoltron (15km) the most beautiful romanic churches of the region; visit then to a marvellous Villa/cellar: a monumental complex positioned in the middle of a green valley surrounded by wooded slopes and marvellous vineyards. At the end of the tour there will be a tasting of wine with a little gastronomic buffet. After the visit lunch in a good farm holiday or back to the hotel. In the afternoon to **Valeggio**, home of tortellini, where you can visit the castle and enjoy stupendous views of the plain, of the Mincio river. ## 3 DAY | VERONA | GARDA LAKE and OIL TOUR

The tour starts with the visit of **Lazise** where you will find impressive reminders of medieval splendours as well. Next to the small harbour is the Dogana Veneta from where for centuries the Republic of Venice controlled all commerce on **Lake Garda**. The story of oil-milling from its beginning as a rural activity to the dawning of the technological age, is the theme of the Oil Museum realized by the oil-mill in **Cisano del Garda**. The museum is a unique exhibition that shows how oil has been produced in rural society for over a thousand years. The tour continues to Sirmione, the most famous village of the area developed inside its castle. From **Sirmione** by private boat to the Garda island, which is now opened to the public. It offers a superb tour through italian, english gardens and two rooms of the impressive Neogothic- venetian Villa. The guests will be accompanied through the visit by the owner. Light refreshments will be served in the villa.

## 4 DAY | VERONA | SOAVE THE WHITE WINE LAND | RICE LAND | VERONA

Visit the village of **Soave** enclosed within medieval city walls attached to the city's ancient castle, later expanded by the Scaliger family and Venetians. Stop in a local wine cellar for a wine tasting. In the afternoon continuing to the Veronese Plain covers a wide area characterized by large rice plantations, churches, historic residences, and castles. It is an internationally recognized marshland oasis. One of the many possible discovery routes in the area begins in **Isola della Scala**, the most important centre for **Vialone Nano rice** cultivation. A visit to a local riseria, or rice farm, educates the visitor on the seasonal cycle of this grain, the importance of local springs in its cultivation.

## **Parmesan cheese & ham - Parma and Reggio Emilia**

## **Truffle - Alba**

The truffle is a subterranean mushroom that lives in total harmony with trees roots. Truffles look like tubers, and consist of a fleshy interior, called "gleba" and are externally covered by bark called "peridio". They contain a high percentage of water, fibres and mineral salts, absorbed from the soil through tree roots. Truffle fair mid October-mid November every year.





# FOOD EXPERIENCE

## **Mortadella - Bologna**

Appetizing and tasty, Mortadella Bologna has a centuries-old history and, not surprisingly, is the sausage most famous culinary tradition of Bolognese. Its roots go as far back as the sixteenth century and the typical Bologna name dates back to 1661, when Cardinal Farnese in Bologna published a notice that encoded the production of this meat and anticipated, in some ways, the current specification.

## **Aceto balsamico - Modena**

Discovering the pleasure of 'agro', proposing a visit to an acetaia and its restaurant which offers a vinegar and the surprising use of a "liquid" whose instruments of production were passed on from generation to generation, forming the "dowry" for girls. Only after an appropriate period of aging, the product reaches the surprising balance of aromas and flavors that can carry the label of origin. Aging that occurs in a series of barrels, different woods and decreasing volume. Each year, the barrel smaller battery provides a few liters of product while the decrease due to the concentration is compensated by the addition of boiled must in the barrel's capacity. During the visits will be given explanations on what are the main rules that are followed to obtain the best Traditional Balsamic Vinegar of Modena, and finally, you can taste the products.

## **Oil Garda Lake**

The story of oil-milling from its beginning as a rural activity to the dawning of the technological age, is the theme of the Oil Museum realized by the oil-mill in Cisano del Garda. The oil story begins in Cisano: "The rural mill from crafts to the industrial technology", this is the thread of the OIL MUSEUM. The oil press from rural craftsmanship to the dawn of the industrial technology: this is the main theme of the MUSEUM OF OLIVE OIL established by Umberto Turri in the spring of 1988. It's an exhibition, unique in its kind, that wants to provide an account of a production system that has involved the rural population for over a millennium. It is also the history of an environment devoid of equipment and scientific knowledge, that was measured for centuries by the urgent need to extract a food of primary importance from its precious fruit. The journey winds around the reality of a static and unchanging technology to reach, at the beginning of the 20th Century, the acquisition of the opportunities provided by the rising of the mechanical industry. Antique and rare instruments used in oil mills from 18th Century up until the beginning of the 20th Century are exhibited, as well as accessories and equipment used in the various eras. An imposing lever press made from oak wood, a water driven wheel mill (perfectly functioning) and other original examples of wooden and iron presses stands out amongst the rest.

## **Rise Isola della Scala/Verona and Mantova**

The Veronese Plain covers a wide area, south of the city, characterized by large rice plantations, churches, historic residences, and castles. It is an internationally recognized marshland oasis. Visit to two beautiful villas: Villa Boschi and Villa Brà: they are XVIth century villas in the green countryside of Isoladella Scala, between rice field and old rural houses. Majestic and elegant are an evidence of the owners old history: noble landowner who lives and governed these cultivations. Transfer than to the splendid little romanic church of Santa Maria di Erbedello. After these visits it takes place a visit to the cultivations still run by the old agricultural families. A member of the staff of the rice-factory will lead you in a tour of a farm and will explain you all the processes of rice production. The visit could be followed by a cooking lesson held by a chef who will show you all the typical dishes you can create with this nourishment. An all rice lunch/dinner will follow to taste the dishes created. One of the many possible discovery routes in the area begins in Isoladella Scala, the most important center for VialoneNano rice cultivation. A visit to a local riseria, or rice farm, educates the visitor on the seasonal cycle of this grain, the importance of local springs in its cultivation, and ancient and modern methods of working and husking the rice. All restaurants and several of the riseria in the area offer tasting menus, based on the local crop.

## SOAVE WINE ROAD

The lands of Soave, a noble white wine made with Garganega and Trebbiano grapes. The itinerary traces its path among wineries, villas, churches and unique landscapes. It starts in Soave, a medieval town, stands inside intact walls that reach the top of the hill standing above it, dominated by a castle. The Castle of Soave is a typical military artifact of the Medieval age representing one of the best example of castle architecture in Veneto. The history of the Castle evolves between feudal quarrels, struggles, factions, barbaric invasions, supremacies and defeats. As place of great and rare charm, this Castle reveals, with real and tangible testimony, the breath of the past along with the ability to enchant and allure whoever is wishful, in silence, to hear its voice. Then walk to a medieval stronghold and an internationally renowned oenological centre. In spectacular underground caves in the rock are stored large oak barrels and small barriques: an ideal place for preserving and ageing wines. The road of the Soave, then continue to San Pietro di Lavagno and Illasi plenty of noble palaces.





# WINE EXPERIENCE

## VALPOLICELLA VERONA

Valpolicella Area is known all over the world for the wine (Amarone and Valpolicella) and the historical small village. San Giorgio Ingannapoltron, the most beautiful romanic church of the region with a wonderful panorama on Valpolicella hills, wine yards and Garda Lake. Then visit to a marvellous Villa-cellar: a monumental complex positioned in the middle of a green valley surrounded by wooded slopes and marvellous vineyards. Here you will see the room where the grapes are withered to produce Amarone's wine, a little wine museum, the large cellars with its old barrels and the distillery.

## VALDOBBIADENE TREVISO PROSECCO

The so-called "Prosecco road" leaves Conegliano passing through Rua di Filetto, that grew around the old Camaldolese Monastery of S. Maria Assunta. The road continues through S. Pietro di Filetto where you can visit the old medieval Pieve (parish church from the twelfth century) with its Romanesque bell-tower, frescoes of the thirteenth century and "Madonna with Babe and Saints" of the fifteenth century. The next stop is Refrontolo, which, as well as its Prosecco, cultivates an excellent Marzemino (red dessert wine). Taking the lane in front of the church you will come to the medieval Molinetto della Croda, a picturesque mill situated among century old trees. The road proceeds onto Pieve di Soligo, Solighetto (where there is a small museum dedicated to the opera

singer Toti Dal Monte at Villa Brandolin), Farra di Soligo, and finally Valdobbiadene, known mainly for its production of Prosecco, and the superior quality called Cartizze.

## FRANCIACORTA BRESCIA

Franciacorta was the first Italian sparkling wine produced exclusively by the Classic Method, or second fermentation in the bottle, to win, in 1995, official status as a Denominazione di Origine Controllata e Garantita (DOCG). Today, the front label on the wine reads simply "Franciacorta": this one term defines the growing area, the production method, and the wine. All of Europe boasts only 10 such privileged wines, and only three of them are made by refermentation in the bottle, Cava, Champagne, and Franciacorta. The area's venerable wine cellars, which today have transformed themselves into cathedrals of modern winemaking technology, proudly produce the four categories of Franciacorta sparkling wines:

- Franciacorta Non Vintage: at least 18 months
- Franciacorta Satèn and Franciacorta Rosé non-vintage: at least 24 months
- Franciacorta Satèn Vintage, Franciacorta Rosé vintage and Franciacorta Vintage: at least 30 months
- Franciacorta Riservas Satèn, Franciacorta Riservas Rosé and Franciacorta Riservas: at least 60 months and also Franciacorta's still wines as well, Curtefranca DOC Bianco and Rosso and Sebino IGT.

## LANGHE TORINO

Travel in the Langhe, a historic region of Piedmont located between the provinces of Cuneo and Asti. The area is a famous tourist destination thanks to its excellent food and wine products and also thanks to the artistic and cultural beauty of the landscapes and the presence of ancient castles and monuments in almost all the territory. The area is famous for its wine production: the world-famous reds Barolo, Nebbiolo, Barbaresco, Dolcetto d'Alba, Dolcetto di Cuneo, Barbera d'Alba, Barbera d'Asti. Equally famous is the white truffles of Alba, the hazelnuts and various cheeses.

## TOSCANA MONTALCINO, CHIANTI

Enjoy the charm of the Chianti countryside, one of the most suggestive areas of Tuscany, well known all over the world not only for its famous wine, but even for its landscapes and vineyards, olive trees and cypresses surrounding churches, parishes, castles and villages hidden among the hills. The trip moves on to Greve in Chianti with a stop in the historic square flanked by open galleries where you can wander around the shops selling typical products of the Chianti area. Then you will visit Castellina in Chianti, a characteristic ancient hamlet set on a hill and nestled between stretches of vineyards and olive groves. Then San Donato in Poggio, an ancient settlement in a fortified castle dating back to the eleventh century, which maintains part of its walls and a stunning Romanesque parish church. Close to Siena the famous village of Montalcino where the Brunello di Montalcino is made.

## Arena di Verona

Its name reflects its role in permitting an opera company to "rise from the ashes" despite losing the use of two theatres (to fire and legal problems respectively). Since opening and being named La Fenice, it has twice burned and been rebuilt. Theatre promenade: welcoming of the group, exclusive private tour of the theater, after which it will be served a cocktail in one of the Apollinee rooms. OPERA SEASON: all year around.

## La Scala Milan

The Scala opera house and its Museum: a point of reference for opera enthusiasts. The Teatro alla Scala Museum was founded in 1913. Just like the opera house, it was restored a few years ago and reopened in 2004 with a new display by Pier Luigi Pizzi. The Teatro alla Scala Museum tells the life of the opera house through a vast collection of musical instruments, portraits, busts and documents dedicated to the greatest musicians, from Giuseppe Verdi to Arturo Toscanini. Visitors can also admire the auditorium from boxes and have the possibility to get to know the backstage machinery during the preparation of a show. OPERA SEASON: all year around (no August)

## Theater dell'Opera- Rome

Teatro dell'Opera o Teatro Costanzi it's the most important theatre in Rome where take place ballets and operas. OPERA SEASON: all year around (no July and August).

## Theater San Carlo Naples

Next to Plebiscito Square, one of the symbols of Naples, stands the shrine to Italian opera, whose foundation precedes the Scala theater in Milan by 41 years and the Fenice theatre in Venice by 55 years. It was in 1737 that the first king of Bourbon, Charles III became the promoter of a project that combined magnificence with amazement and became a clear sign of his power: a theater! OPERA SEASON: all year around (no July and August).

## Cremona

The medieval town hall square is without a doubt the most charming part of the town and the best place to start a tour of discovery of Cremona with its history and art. The Torrazzo (1), the tallest stone bell tower in Italy, the Cathedral (2), an interesting example of Romanesque-Lombard architecture, the octagonal Baptistery (3), the thirteenth century Town Hall its Collection of Stringed Instruments (4) and the Loggia of the Militia (5) surround the town's main square which in times gone by excelled to the point that it competed with Milan. Leaving the square, crossing piazza Stradivari you reach corso Vittorio Emanuele. "Ponchielli" Theatre (6) overlooks this street and was rebuilt in neoclassical style in 1806 by the Milanese architect Luigi Canonica on the site of the seventeenth century Teatro "Concordia". Visit visita alla sala dei violini, presso il comune di Cremona, dov'è esposta una collezione di violini famosi. Audizione gratuita di uno degli strumenti esposti. Visita al museo civico e Stradivariano, che raccoglie oggetti e documentazione relativi ai personaggi più rappresentativi della vita musicale e della tradizione liutaria di Cremona; interessanti soprattutto i disegni autografi, i modelli e gli attrezzi da lavoro dello Stradivari e i manoscritti di Ponchielli. OPERA SEASON: all year around (no July and August).

## Macerata

The Sferisterio of Macerata stands out as one of the most prominent architectural structures of the late European Neoclassical Style. In the first half of the Nineteenth century, a few wealthy gentlemen living in Macerata decided to enrich their city with a permanent structure used to host the game with ball and bangle and, at the same time, as an arena for the 'steccato' and for bull fighting, which was very popular at the time of the Papal State. Construction began on 2 October, 1820, according to the drawings provided by Salvatore Innocenzi. The Sferisterio was inaugurated on 5 September, 1829. The very special shape of the building which includes a playing field, a series of rooms for various purposes, a supporting wall, boxes and balconies was carefully designed to encompass the needs of the sports activities which were popular in the first half of the Nineteenth century. The building, which is in line with the best Neoclassical taste and betrays a Palladian influence, is not only magnificent per se, but it perfectly blends with the city landscape. The harmonious structure ensures perfect visibility and wonderful acoustics. Over the years which saw Claudio Orazi as artistic director, the Sferisterio welcomed on its stage all the best international performers like Luciano Pavarotti, Plácido Domingo, Monserrat Caballè, Marilyn Horne, Fiorenza Cossotto, Ruggero Raimondi, Mariella Devia, José Carreras, Katia Ricciarelli and Renato Bruson. OPERA SEASON: July and August.

## Torre del Lago, Puccini Festival - Lucca

Established in 1930, over the years, it has become increasingly prestigious and draws thousands of spectators from all over the world. Torre del Lago is a favorite destination of opera lovers and tourists who want to visit the environment and the native land of the most beloved composer of the 20th century. During more than seventy years of history the most famous and acclaimed opera singers took the stage at the Festival Puccini. Close to Torre del Lago, Lucca has a very long history whose traces still remain in his walls, squares, churches, buildings. A Roman colony, as witnessed by the Amphitheatre and the two streets running North - South and East - West and meeting in the Forum, today Piazza San Michele, in 570 it became an important centre of Longobard power and capital town of Tuscia. In 1162 Lucca became a free municipality governed by rich silk trade companies and seat of a mint. Since the second half of 1500 Lucca changed into an independent aristocratic Republic: in order to defend its freedom against Florence and the Este to the north, town-walls were enlarged and fortified.

The strong walls and ramparts, nowadays planted with trees, are one of the town symbols. In 1799 Lucca was occupied by the French and became Principality of Felice and Elisa Baiocchi, Napoleon's sister. After Bonaparte's fall, Lucca was a dukedom under the Borbonis until 1847, when it entered the Tuscan Government. Giacomo Puccini was born here on December 22nd, 1858. OPERA SEASON: July and August.

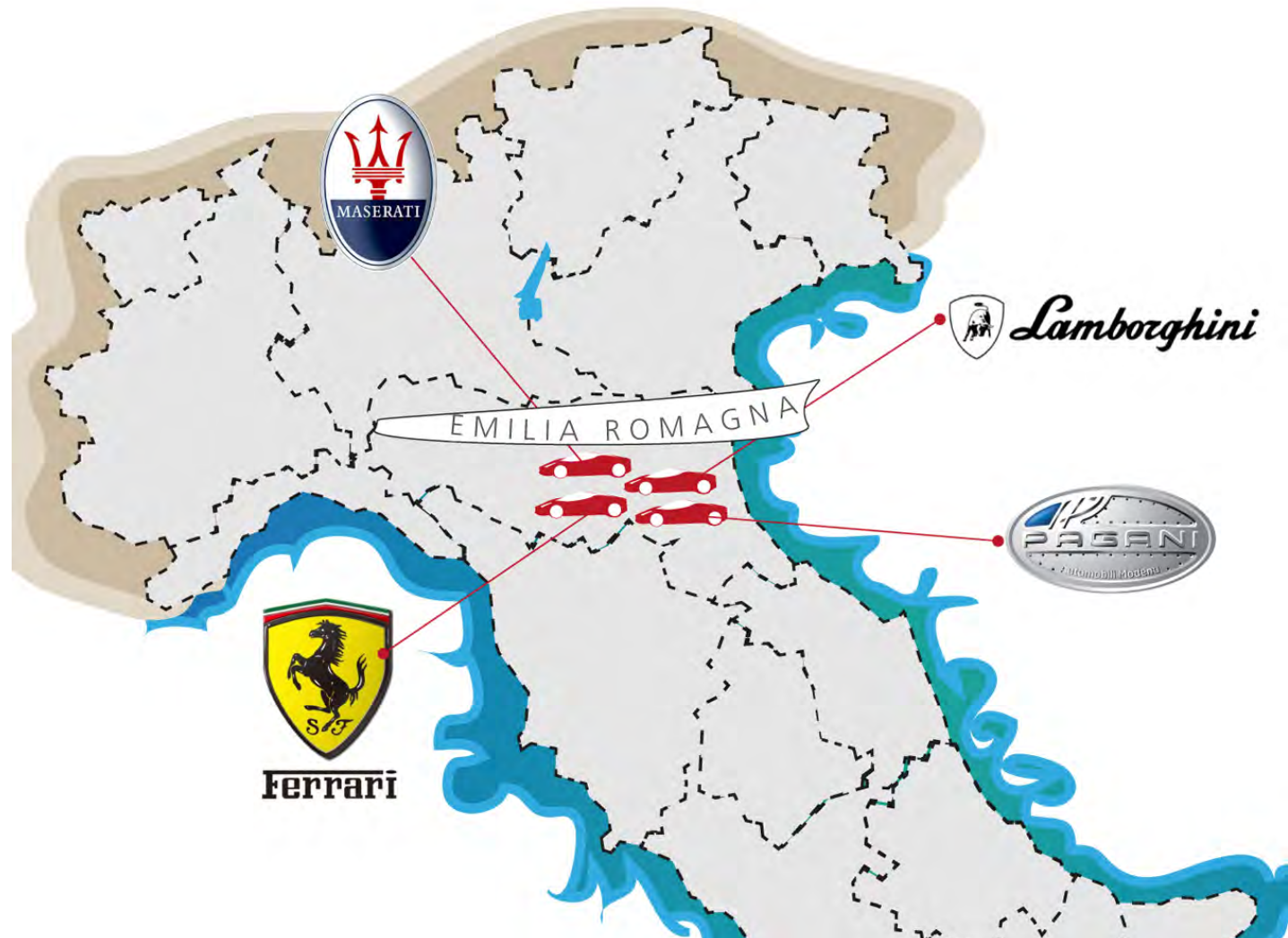

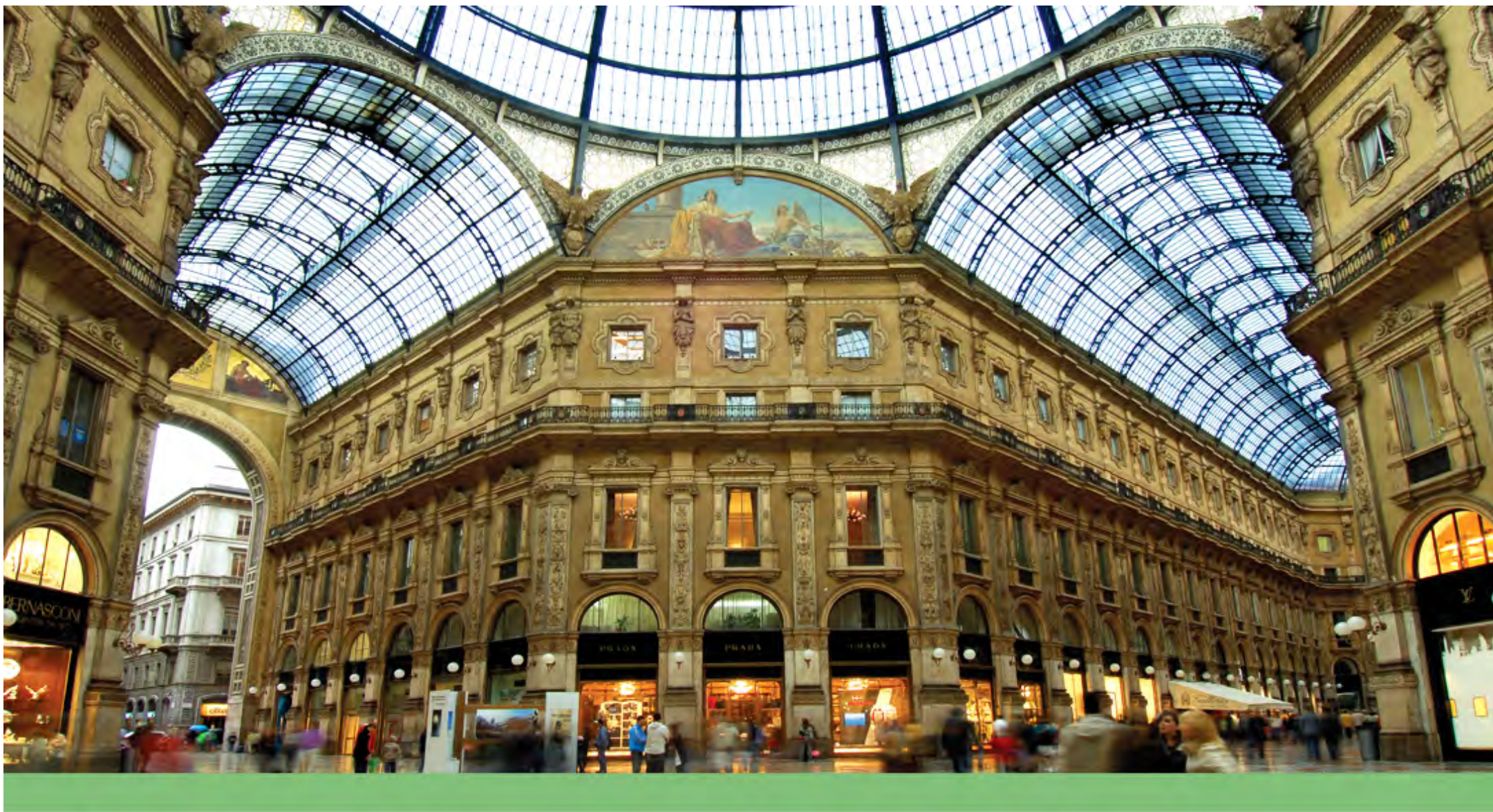

It was built in 1928 and enlarged to 18 holes in 1951 in a spectacular strip of land between the Adriatic Sea and the Lagoon of Venice. It shares several links features and the bora and sirocco winds that often impact the course, increase the challenge and require game control to hit the greens, which are well protected by bunkers.

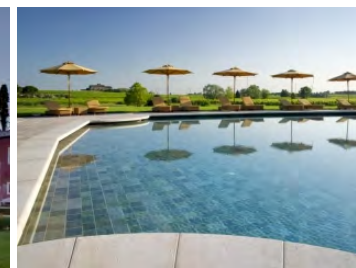

# GARDA LAKE
